- 1. First Item of business, Brandi Weinrich donated a pup to be auctioned off. Titus Yeubanks was the auctioneer and sold the pup to Tony Jetensky for \$500 with proceeds going to the SWCDA.
- 2. Next, new board members were nominated and elected being Jeff Christiansen stepping in for Zach Long and Corey Bentke stepping in for Amanda Clayton.
- 3. It was voted and approved to keep the Officers the same as last year.

There was a long discussion on rule verifications, so after discussions, motions were made, seconded and passed to require:

- 4. Along with the Dog of the Year and Reserve Dog of the Year, Finals Champion and Finals Reserve Champion will be require to move up in class if there are 10 dogs or more in that class entered in the finals.
- Novice and Intermediate dogs that acquire the status of Dog of the Year, Reserve Dog of the Year, Finals Champion or Reserve Finals Champion, <u>both dog and handler</u> will move up in class. Example: Novice to Intermediate, Intermediate to Ranch.
- 6. Year will officially end Oct. 1 of each year.
